UAE already has an integrated state-level emergency system led by the NCEMA.

This system is designed to have a high level of emergency preparedness and response for all types of emergencies including health.

Activating the national plan to combat human epidemics, holding meetings of the national team for emergency and crisis management, and meetings of the technical team every 48 hours

A National Technical Advisory Team for COVID-19
Pandemics was established from all concerned authorities
and Ministries to assess the situation, recommend the
procedures that need to be taken on daily basis at all stages
of the pandemic, addressing its consequences and follow-up
implementation of the recommendations.



ALHOSN application


