Global Goods for Universal Health Coverage – from innovation to impact

Background

Universal Health Coverage is very high on the global health agenda: it is a prominent target of the Health SDG (3), and a top priority of WHO.

Accordingly, new initiatives and networks have been created, many high-level meetings held and declarations made. In order to advance towards UHC, the different efforts not only need to be aligned, but also tangible innovations be developed and driven by the new coalition of partners (governments, NGOs, science and academy and private sector).

Objectives

This side event will present a series of innovative global goods which have been developed by groups of partners, tested at the local level and are now used at scale at national, regional or global level.

The panellists will present a mixture of digital and analogue tools and will emphasise the importance of the human factor, e.g. the relevance of leadership competences and peer learning opportunities that have been crucial for the scaling up of these goods.

Content (order of presentation to be defined as well as panellists)

- The <u>Leadership for UHC programme</u> builds both the individual and collective capacities of people who are responsible for moving UHC forward in their countries. The programme is implemented by the P4H global network for social health protection.
 - Country and possible panellist: P4H Coordination Desk
- The openIMIS is an open source management information system for health financing schemes including insurance.
 - o Country and possible panellist: Example from Tanzania or Nepal
- <u>leDA</u> is a tool developed to improve the quality of primary health care consultations through mHealth. Burkina Faso has decided to scale up its application nationwide.
 - Country and possible panellist: Example from Burkina Faso
- The <u>SwipeRX</u> network by social enterprise <u>www.mclinica.com</u> is a mobile-phone based professional network for pharmaceutical professionals. It links pharmacists and pharmacies, and it provides access to information and credited professional training from both public and private stakeholders. Its aim is a direct contribution to UHC in the pivotal pharmaceutical segment of the health system. It can be seen as a tool for empowerment of a professional group that works at the direct crossroads of public and personal health care interests.
