Real Estate Fund

Report by the Director-General

This document reports on the current status of the various projects being financed from the Real Estate Fund. Part II contains suggested action by the Executive Board.

The Annex contains a table showing the estimated situation of the Fund as at 31 December 1997, and an appendix shows obligations and expected obligations up to that date.

I. STATUS OF PROJECTS CURRENTLY UNDERTAKEN OR TO BE UNDERTAKEN PRIOR TO 31 MAY 1998

Regional Office for Africa

- 1. The project for the replacement of the wiring of the print shop in the Regional Office for Africa has been completed within the previously estimated amount of US\$ 100 000.1
- 2. An order has been placed for the replacement of the main passenger lift in the Regional Office; no delivery has been possible due to the current situation in Brazzaville. The estimated amount for this project continues to be US\$ 130 000.
- 3. The replacement of the air-conditioning unit for the computer and print rooms in the Regional Office has been completed within the previously estimated cost of US\$ 120 000.
- 4. The following six projects were approved by the Executive Board at its ninety-ninth session and by the Fiftieth World Health Assembly. However, in view of the situation in the host country no implementation action has been taken so far.²
 - (1) Creation of a reservoir for fresh-water supply for the compound housing the Regional Office for Africa and surrounding residences for an estimated amount of US\$ 160 000.

- (2) Extension of the main conference hall of the Regional Office for Africa for an estimated amount of US\$ 400 000.
- (3) Creation of septic tanks for waste disposal for the Regional Office for Africa and the residences surrounding it for an estimated amount of US\$ 313 000.
- (4) Replacement of the water-proofing of the roof of the Regional Office for Africa for an estimated amount of US\$ 288 000.
- (5) Installation of security lighting and fire detection equipment inside the Regional Office for Africa for an estimated amount of US\$ 298 000.
- (6) Installation of external lighting in the compound housing the Regional Office for Africa and surrounding residences for an estimated amount of US\$ 195 000.

Regional Office for the Americas/Pan American Sanitary Bureau

- 5. The construction of the Caribbean Programme Coordination office in Barbados has been completed and the share to be charged to the Real Estate Fund should not exceed the previously revised amount of US\$ 401 860.1
- 6. The construction of the PAHO/WHO Representative's office in Mexico remains in abeyance. The approved estimated charge to the Real Estate Fund is US\$ 250 000.2

Regional Office for South-East Asia

- 7. Negotiations with the local government authorities for the addition of one floor to the Regional Office building are still under way. It is not clear at this stage when final approval will be obtained. The costs of the project should remain within the previously estimated amount of US\$ 145 000.²
- 8. The renovation/restructuring of the Regional Office building is now well under way and it is expected to complete the project within the previously estimated amount of US\$ 400 000.2

Regional Office for the Eastern Mediterranean

9. The Executive Board at its ninety-ninth session and the Fiftieth World Health Assembly approved the construction of a Regional Office building for the Eastern Mediterranean Region in Cairo, at a cost to the Real Estate Fund not exceeding US\$ 9 890 000. The basis of the design report has been established for this project and it is expected to call for tenders in early 1998. The tentative date for completion of the new building is towards the end of 1999.³

Regional Office for the Western Pacific

10. Work on the renovation of the main conference hall of the Regional Office for the Western Pacific has been completed within the previously estimated amount of US\$ 406 000.2

Headquarters

- 11. The work on the new structures and installations of the sub-basement of the headquarters building has been completed within the previously estimated Swiss franc equivalent of US\$ 1 780 000, adjusted to reflect Swiss franc/US dollar exchange rate fluctuations.
- 12. Work on the replacement of the headquarters Local Area Network (LAN) continues to progress satisfactorily, certain elements of the new LAN being already operational. The project should be completed by mid-1998 within the previously estimated Swiss franc equivalent of US\$ 6 765 000, adjusted to reflect Swiss franc/US dollar exchange rate fluctuations.

II. ACTION BY THE EXECUTIVE BOARD

13. In the light of the above, the Executive Board may wish to take note of the progress on various projects financed by the Real Estate Fund for the period 1 June 1997 to 31 May 1998.
