《职员细则》修订款1

秘书处的报告

1. 本文件提出的修订出自联合国大会第五十七届会议根据国际公务员制度委员会 (ICSC)的建议作出的决定。根据《职员条例》12.2条,总干事现提交这些修订款供执 委会确认。秘书处在国际公务员制度委员会的基础上形成的报告²含有建议的依据。

专业人员以上职类薪酬

- 2. 报告中提出,委员会建议有差别地增加专业人员以上职类薪资表的薪酬,幅度从 P.1 级的 0.45%至 D.1 级的 13.3% (D.2 以上级别的 10.7%),平均增加 5.7%。目的不仅是针对整体差额水平³,而且也针对薪资表中较高职等的低差额水平以及薪资表中较低职等的高差额水平。
- 3. 经过广泛的讨论,联合国大会在 2002 年 12 月 20 日的 57/285 号决议中批准下述按级别的实际净提薪: P.4: 1.3%, P.5: 2.6%, D.1: 9.1%, D.2: 6.3%。自 2003 年 1 月 1 日开始生效的这些增加的薪资将使这些级别的差额水平达到 111 和超过 112.2, 对于 P.1 至 P.3 级别未批准提薪, 这些级别的差额已达到或超过 115 的中点。
- 4. 对《职员细则》330.2条进行了如附件中所示的相应修订。

不叙级职位职员和总干事的薪酬

- 5. 作为对联合国大会上述决定的补充,总干事根据《职员条例》3.1 条建议执行委员会应向第五十六届世界卫生大会提出修订不叙级职位薪酬的建议。从而,不叙级职位的毛工资每年为169366美元,净工资为115207美元(有受抚养人者)或104324美元(单身者)。
- 6. 应对总干事的薪酬作出相似的调整,从而这一职位的毛工资为 228 403 美元,相应的净工资为 151 810 美元(有受抚养者)或 135 000 美元(单身者)。

教育补助金水平的审查

7. 联合国大会通过了委员会关于提高七个国家或货币区域的认可费用最高限额和教育补助金最高限额: 奥地利(欧元)、瑞士(瑞士法郎)、西班牙(欧元)、大不列颠及北爱尔兰联合王国(英磅)、意大利(欧元)、美国国内的美元以及美国之外的美元。还提高了某些指定工作地点的膳宿费用最高限额。教育补助金金额的变化将于 2003 年 1 月 1 日开始的学年适用。从而对《职员细则》 350.1、350.2.2 和 355 条进行了如所附附件中的修订。

危险工作津贴

8. 联合国大会要求委员会在 2003 年中再次考虑其关于提高高危地点当地征聘工作人员的危险工作津贴。

财政影响

- 9. 提高专业人员以上职类薪资表的薪酬造成的财务影响估计将使正常预算每个双年度增加大约800万美元,预算外资源每双年度约增加700万美元。对2002 2003年双年度造成的财务影响正常预算约为400万美元,预算外资源约为350万美元。
- 10. 教育补助金的增加数额1将由向各区域及全球和区域间活动的拨款中支付。

第五十六届世界卫生大会,

注意到执行委员会有关不叙级职位职员和总干事薪酬的建议,

- 1. **确定**不叙级职位的工资在交纳薪金税前为每年 169 366 美元,因而修订的净工资为 115 207 美元(有受抚养人者)或 104 324 美元(单身者);
- 2. **确定**总干事的工资在交纳薪金税前为每年 228 403 美元,因而修订的净工资为 151 810 美元(有受抚养人者)或 135 000 美元(单身者);
- 3. 决定对薪酬的这些调整从2003年1月1日起生效。
