### Methodological notes

#### Summary schedules: basis of preparation

In the Global Management System, each voluntary contribution is recorded through an award. The summary schedules reproduced in the present document aggregate those awards, reporting contributions by fund and by donor. Donor contributions whose value is less than US\$ 10 000 are grouped together and reported as “Other”.

#### Revenue recognition

Voluntary contributions are recorded on an accrual basis. Formal funding agreements signed by both parties are required in order to recognize an asset before the receipt of cash. When the entire funding is payable up front, revenue equal to the funding set out in the agreement is recognized when the agreement is signed. When funds are transferred over the period of the agreement, revenue is recognized as the conditions to receive that funding are satisfied.

The Secretariat of the WHO Framework Convention on Tobacco Control and the Stop TB Partnership Global Drug Facility, although not included within the programme budget, were also reported in the General Fund. The Revolving Fund for Teaching and Laboratory Equipment is a Special Purpose Fund.
