Framework of engagement with non-State actors

Draft decision resulting from a working group

The Sixty-seventh World Health Assembly,

Having considered the report on the framework of engagement with non-State actors; welcoming the progress made on the draft framework of engagement with non-State actors by the Sixty-seventh World Health Assembly; underlining the importance of an appropriate framework for engagement with non-State actors for the role and work of WHO; and recognizing that further consultation is needed on issues including conflict of interest and relations with the private sector,

- (1) called upon Member States to submit their specific follow-up questions to the Director-General by 6 June 2014;
- (2) requested the Director-General:
 - (1) to prepare a report in response to the Health Assembly's comments and the follow-up questions raised;
 - (2) to consult further with Member States during the regional committees, in 2014 on the basis of the draft framework of engagement with non-State actors and the report referred to in subparagraph (2)(1) above;
 - (3) to submit an account of the further consultations undertaken in 2014 and the proposed way forward to the Executive Board at its 136th session in January 2015.
