

Statement of the Delegation of the Republic of Indonesia
on
Agenda item 17 The highest attainable standard of health
for persons with disabilities
at
the 152nd Session of the Executive Board
Geneva, 30 January - 7 February 2023

Thank you, Chair,

First of all, we would like to appreciate the Secretariat for preparing the report under this agenda item.

Indonesia has been implementing a community-based rehabilitation program since 2017. The program is continuously adapted according to the upcoming roadmap which involves 4 ministries to create 50 primary health cares with disability friendly features.

Cadres' empowerment and community training are promoted to perform home care for chronic illness patients, such as post stroke patients. We are also planning to conduct disabilities management benchmarking with other countries which have similar conditions.

In addition, we also identify the opportunity to link disabilities care with mental health care. We propose to emphasize the alignment of disabilities care with mental health care as well as the connection between social determinants of health and well-being and health promotion.

In conclusion, Indonesia remains committed to support the implementation of the Political declaration of the third high-level meeting of the General Assembly on the prevention and control of non-communicable diseases, and mental health.
