AGENDA 19.2 FINANCING AND IMPLEMENTATION OF THE PROGRAMME BUDGET
2022-2023 AND OUTLOOK ON THE FINANCING OF THE PROGRAMME BUDGET 2024-
2025**

Thank you, Chair.

1. Indonesia welcomes the WHO Secretariat's endeavour to provide the Member States with a better quality presentation of the Programme budget 2022-2023 implementation reports and an outlook on the financing of the Proposed Programme Budget 2024-2025.
2. A comparative presentation on flexible funds based on geographical and technical outcomes is useful to assess how effective and impactful the Programme budget 2022-2023 is, nevertheless, we expect that it could be linked with WHO's costs savings and efficiency gains that have been depicted in the document A76/19 for better understanding on the budget implementation.
3. Indonesia encourages Secretariat to improve efficiency gains in the current Programme budget 2022-2023 implementation towards the end of the year, therefore it would promote the value of money of the programme budget. We also advise that total frequency and the scope of reporting are adjusted by the needs of fulfilling the accountability and transparency aspect but at the same time depicting the efforts to achieve the cost-effectiveness of the programme budget implementation.
4. We wish that our efforts can create a better practice of collaboration, communication, and coordination between Member States and WHO and ensure that programs are in line with the priorities of individual countries and at the same time can address regional, and global needs.
