## STATEMENT THE DELEGATION OF THE REPUBLIC OF INDONESIA AT THE 150<sup>th</sup> EXECUTIVE BOARD AGENDA ITEM 19.2 AND 19.4 28 JANUARY 2022

Thank you Chair,

Indonesia takes the floor on Agenda item 19.2 and 19.4.

Indonesia appreciates the support provided in assisting member states in achieving the increased target of UHC to cover 720 million people by sustaining essential health services, and rebuild national health systems, with a focus on primary health care.

We support the resolution to extend the GPW13 to 2025.

On the scale of assessment adjustment, including the proposed increase in Indonesia's assessed contribution to the WHO in accordance with the United Nation's General Assembly resolution needs to be determined by considering multiple factors.

Indonesia concurs that assessed contribution will provide a good return of investment if it is utilized as effective and efficient as possible.

With the adjustment of the scale of assessment for the biennium 2022-2023, we request WHO to also improve budget implementation transparency and accountability, at the global, regional and country level, in line with the ongoing reform of WHO.

This is particularly important considering that several proposed new initiatives require further involvement of Member States and their implementation at country level, such as the Universal Health and Preparedness Review and the BioHub System, will definitely have significant implication on the organization's budget in its implementation.
