Thank you Chair,

- Malaysia takes note of the rationale explained in the report for the extension of the 13th General Programme of Work to 2025 and supports this agenda.
- Undoubtedly, the pandemic has exposed inequalities among countries. With the loss of lives and disruption of livelihoods, global progress in increasing life expectancy, reducing child & maternal mortality and the fight against non-communicable diseases have deterred.

- 3. Malaysia recognizes that Triple Billion Targets of GPW 13 were designed to help achieve the Sustainable Development Goals in particularly health-related SDG3. However today, we are nowhere close to addressing the gaps with little or no progress towards these ambitious goals.
