COMMITTEE ON CREDENTIALS

First Report



The Committee on Credentials met on 3 March 1964.

Delegates of the following Members were present:

Afghanistan, Cameroon, Colombia, Finland, Hungary, Iceland, Iran, Luxembourg, Nicaragua, New Zealand, Sierra Leone, Tunisia.

Dr L. Molitor (Luxembourg) was elected Chairman, Mr M. A. O. Findlay (Sierra Leone) Vice-Chairman, and Mr M. Laafif (Tunisia) Rapporteur.

The Committee examined the credentials deposited by the delegations taking part in the Health Assembly.

1. The credentials presented by the delegations and representatives listed below were found to be in order, thus entitling these delegations and representatives to take part in the work of the Health Assembly, as defined by the Constitution of the World Health Organization. The Committee therefore proposes that the Health Assembly should recognize the validity of the credentials presented by the following delegations and representatives: Afghanistan, Albania, Algeria, Argentina, Australia, Austria, Belgium, Brazil, Bulgaria, Burma, Burundi, Cambodia, Cameroon, Canada, Central African Republic, Ceylon, Chad, Chile, China, Colombia, Congo (Leopoldville), Cuba, Czechoslovakia, Denmark, Dominican Republic, El Salvador, Ethiopia, Federal Republic of Germany, Finland, France, Gabon, Ghana, Greece, Guatemala, Guinea, Honduras, Hungary, Iceland, India, Indonesia, Iran, Iraq, Ireland, Israel, Italy, Ivory Coast, Jamaica, Japan, Jordan, Kenya, Kuwait, Laos, Lebanon, Libya, Luxembourg, Madagascar, Malaysia, Mali, Mauritania, Mexico, Monaco, Mongolia, Morocco, Nepal, New Zealand, Nicaragua, Niger, Nigeria, Norway, Pakistan, Panama, Paraguay, Peru,

Philippines, Poland, Portugal, Republic of Korea, Republic of Viet Nam, Romania, Rwanda, Saudi Arabia, Senegal, Sierra Leone, Somalia, Sudan, Sweden, Switzerland, Tanganyika, Thailand, Togo, Trinidad and Tobago, Tunisia, Turkey, Uganda, Union of Soviet Socialist Republics, United Arab Republic, United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, United States of America, Upper Volta, Venezuela, Yugoslavia, Zanzibar and Mauritius (Associate Member).

2. Notifications from Bolivia, Congo (Brazzaville), Costa Rica, Dahomey, Ecuador, Liberia, Netherlands, South Africa, Spain, Syria and Yemen giving the composition of their delegations, state that credentials are being forwarded, and the Committee therefore recommends to the Health Assembly that these delegations be recognized with full rights in the Health Assembly pending the arrival of their formal credentials.

3. The delegate of Hungary contested the validity of the credentials presented by the Republic of China.
