APPOINTMENT OF THE REGIONAL DIRECTOR FOR SOUTH-EAST ASIA

As reflected in document EB31/6, the Regional Committee for South-East Asia at its fifteenth session adopted the following resolution with regard to the appointment of the Regional Director:

"The Regional Committee,

Whereas Article 52 of the Constitution of the World Health Organization provides that the Regional Director shall be appointed by the Executive Board in agreement with the Regional Committee,

1. RECOMMENDS the extension of Dr C. Mani's contract for a period not exceeding five years from 1 March 1963; and
2. TRANSMITS this recommendation to the Executive Board."

Dr Mani reaches the age of 60 in November 1963.

In view of the action taken by the Board in similar circumstances, it may wish to consider the adoption of the following resolution:

"The Executive Board,

Considering the provisions of Article 52 of the Constitution, Staff Regulation 45 and Staff Rule 920; and

Having considered the recommendation of the Regional Committee for South-East Asia,

1. REAPPOINTS Dr C. Mani as Regional Director for South-East Asia as from 1 March 1963; and
2. AUTHORIZES the Director-General to extend Dr Mani's appointment as Regional Director for a further period of five years from that date without further reference to the Executive Board and subject to the provisions of the Staff Rules and Regulations."
