**PREPARATION OF A FIFTH REGIONAL PROGRAMME
OF WORK FOR A SPECIFIC PERIOD (1978-1983 INCLUSIVE)**

**Working Group to examine regional action
in connexion with the
Sixth General Programme of Work**

Proposed Terms of Reference

A working group has been set up to examine, in depth, the future action to be taken in the Western Pacific Region in connexion with the WHO Sixth General Programme of Work (1978-1983).

- (i) The working party should examine and propose to the Regional Committee possible ways and means of setting up a mechanism whereby the Regional Committee could regularly review the progress made in the Western Pacific Region towards the development and implementation of the Sixth Programme of Work.
- (ii) The working party should report to the Regional Committee which could then propose to the World Health Assembly and the Executive Board specific programmes which the Committee considers to be of the highest priority for in-depth studies by the Executive Board.
- (iii) The working party should, with reference to resolution WHA29.48, propose to the Regional Committee a definition of "technical cooperation" to be suggested to the Executive Board for preparation of its definition of the term "technical cooperation".
