The Regional Committee of the Western Pacific,

HAVING considered the points raised in the Technical
Discussions during its Third Session;

REQUESTS Member Countries of the Region:

1. To lay more emphasis on the teaching of Public Health in the undergraduate medical course and to include in the medical curriculum a period of at least 6 weeks of field public health clerkship;
2. To consider the giving of better remuneration to their Public Health Personnel;
3. That in the employment of Public Health Personnel, preference be given to those who have taken post-graduate courses in Public Health.
