ESTABLISHMENT OF PHARMACEUTICAL PRODUCTION IN
DEVELOPING COUNTRIES

(Draft resolution proposed by Dr S. P. W. Street and Dr V. P. Vassilopoulos)

The Executive Board,

Having considered the report of the Director-General¹ on the Establishment of Pharmaceutical Production in Developing Countries,

1. THANKS the Director-General for the presentation of this report and the work being done in this field;
2. TRANSMITS the report to the Twenty-fourth World Health Assembly; and
3. RECOMMENDS to the Twenty-fourth World Health Assembly that it invite the Director-General:
 - (a) to continue the co-operation with the United Nations Industrial Development Organization (UNIDO), in assisting developing countries to establish pharmaceutical production; and
 - (b) to provide within the limits of available resources assistance to the health authorities of Member States in the promotion of rational drug therapy and the assessment of a drug consumption level which meets best therapeutic needs and socio-economic objectives.
