REPORT OF COMMITTEE B TO COMMITTEE A

Committee B reviewed the amount of casual income available from miscellaneous income and the cash portion of the Assembly Suspense Account in the light of a report by the Director-General.¹ It also took into consideration an expected increase in the estimated reimbursement from the United Nations Development Programme.

On the basis of its review, Committee B recommends to Committee A that income in the amount of US\$ 3 800 000 be used to help finance the 1976 budget, and that a substantial amount be devoted to programmes designed to improve the health conditions of the people in the least developed and most seriously affected countries.

The amount of US\$ 3 800 000 is composed of the expected reimbursement from the United Nations Development Programme in the amount of US\$ 2 300 000, and the amount of US\$ 1 500 000 of available casual income.
