FIRST REPORT OF COMMITTEE B TO COMMITTEE A

Committee B reviewed the amount of casual income available from miscellaneous income and the cash portion of the Assembly Suspense Account in the light of a report by the Director-General.¹ It also took into consideration the estimated reimbursement of programme support costs for activities financed from extrabudgetary funds.

On the basis of its review, Committee B recommends to Committee A that income in the amount of US\$ 4 600 000 be used to help finance the 1977 budget. The amount of US\$ 4 600 000 is composed of the estimated reimbursement of programme support costs for activities financed from extrabudgetary funds in the amount of US\$ 2 600 000, and the amount of US\$ 2 000 000 of available casual income.
