ASSESSMENT OF THE SOLOMON ISLANDS

The Thirty-sixth World Health Assembly,

Noting that the Solomon Islands, a Member of the United Nations, became a Member of the World Health Organization by depositing with the Secretary-General of the United Nations a formal instrument of acceptance of the WHO Constitution on 4 April 1983;

Noting that the United Nations General Assembly, in resolution 37/125, established the assessment of the Solomon Islands at the rate of 0.01% for the years 1983 to 1985;

Recalling the principle established in resolution WHA8.5, and confirmed in resolution WHA24.12, that the latest available United Nations scale of assessments should be used as a basis for determining the scale of assessments to be used by WHO;

Recalling further that the Twenty-sixth World Health Assembly, in resolution WHA26.21, affirmed its belief that the scale of assessments in WHO should follow as closely as possible that of the United Nations;

DECIDES:

- (1) that the Solomon Islands shall be assessed at the rate of 0.01% for the second year of the financial period 1982-1983 and for future financial periods.
- (2) that the Solomon Islands' assessment relating to the year 1983 shall be reduced to one-third of 0.01%.
