Appointment of representatives to the WHO Staff Pension Committee

The World Health Assembly is called upon to appoint two representatives to the WHO Staff Pension Committee to replace a member and an alternate member whose terms of office expire at the closure of the Fiftieth World Health Assembly.

INTRODUCTION

1. In conformity with the Regulations of the United Nations Joint Staff Pension Fund, and in accordance with resolution WHA2.49 of the Second World Health Assembly, WHO has a Staff Pension Committee composed of nine members (and nine alternate members) - one-third appointed by the World Health Assembly, one-third appointed by the Director-General, and one-third elected by the participants in the Fund.
2. The present representatives of the Health Assembly are:
 - (1) appointed by the Forty-seventh World Health Assembly for three years from 1994 (decision WHA47(11)):
 - Professor B. Roos from Switzerland (in a personal capacity);
 - the member of the Executive Board designated by the Government of Kuwait (as alternate);
 - (2) appointed by the Forty-eighth World Health Assembly for three years from 1995 (decision WHA48(11)):
 - Dr J. Larivière, member of the delegation of Canada to the Forty-eighth World Health Assembly;
 - Dr V. Tangcharoensathien, member of the delegation of Thailand to the Forty-eighth World Health Assembly (as alternate);
