

WHA3.42 Supplies for Governmental Programmes

In view of the difficulties experienced by certain governments in obtaining medical supplies for their programmes,

The Third World Health Assembly

REQUESTS the Executive Board to study the question of freer and quicker supplies to governments including the possibility of setting up a revolving fund to meet this purpose, on the understanding that in every case governments would be willing to pay in their own currencies.
