

EB51.R41 Organizational study on methods of promoting the development of basic health services

The Executive Board,

Recalling resolution WHA24.38, by which the Health Assembly requested the Executive Board to carry out an organizational study on methods of promoting the development of basic health services, and taking into account other Health Assembly resolutions on the development of health services, in particular WHA23.61, on the basic principles for the development of national health systems, and WHA25.17, on research in the organization of community health services,

1. TRANSMITS its study ² to the Twenty-sixth World Health Assembly;
2. INVITES the attention of the Assembly to its findings, conclusions and recommendations and, in particular, to the main recommendation that each Member country should develop a health service that is both accessible and acceptable to the total population, suited to its needs and the socioeconomic conditions of the country;
3. REQUESTS the Director-General to take the conclusions and recommendations of the study into account in the planning and execution of future programmes of the Organization; and
4. AGREES, in view of the importance of the development of health services, to keep this area under regular review.
