12.2.8.2.1. Transportation and/or per diem allowances
for Delegates to Second World Health Assembly

The Interim Commission decided, at its fifth session¹ that subsistence (per diem) allowances should not be paid to delegates attending the first World Health Assembly and that transportation expenses should be paid for one delegate only from each country.

The committee should consider whether it wishes to recommend to the Assembly that it authorize the payment of transportation and/or per diem allowances for delegates to the second World Health Assembly or whether it prefers to make no recommendation.

Should the committee decide to recommend the payment of transportation expenses to one delegate from each country, it may wish to pass a resolution on the following lines:

The Committee on Administration and Finance proposes to the Health Assembly that it authorize the reimbursement to each Member of the World Health Organization of the actual travelling expenses of one delegate only to the second World Health Assembly, the maximum reimbursement to be restricted to the equivalent of first-class return accommodation by recognized public transport via an approved route from the capital city of the Member to the place of the meeting and not to include the payment of subsistence except where this is included as an integral part of the regular posted schedule for first-class accommodation for recognized public transport.
