## **Proposed programme budget for 2004-2005**

1. In the light of comments made by the Executive Board during its review of the Proposed programme budget for 2004-2005, it was agreed that a table should be submitted to the Health Assembly comparing the figures estimated two years ago for other sources of funds in 2002-2003 with current estimates. The requested information can be found in the table overleaf.

2. The table also updates the estimates for the biennium 2004-2005. Changes from the data contained in the Proposed programme budget  $2004-2005^1$  are indicated in italics. They include the estimated percentage of resources that will be spent at (i) country, (ii) regional and (iii) global levels.

3. It should be noted that the total under other sources of funds is now estimated at US\$ 1 824 500 000, as compared to the earlier estimate of US\$ 1 898 000 000 shown in the Proposed programme budget 2004-2005.
