Appointment of the Regional Director for South-East Asia

1. The present appointment of Dr Uton Muchtar Rafei as Regional Director for South-East Asia expires on 29 February 2004.
2. At its fifty-sixth session, the Regional Committee for South-East Asia, in accordance with the provisions of Article 52 of the Constitution of the World Health Organization, and with Rule 49 of its own Rules of Procedure, nominated Dr Samlee Plianbangchang as Regional Director for South-East Asia and adopted the following resolution:¹

The Regional Committee,

Considering Article 52 of the Constitution, and

In accordance with Rule 49 of its Rules of Procedure,

1. **NOMINATES** Dr Samlee Plianbangchang as Regional Director for South-East Asia, and
2. **REQUESTS** the Director-General to propose to the Executive Board the appointment of Dr Samlee Plianbangchang for a period of five years from 1 March 2004.
