CORRIGENDUM

The second sentence of paragraph 3 should read as follows:

By definition, estimates of that burden and DALYs lost are restricted to the consequences of disease and injury, and do not account for **other** effects on society as a whole or the social problems that affect drinkers and those close to them, including nondrinkers.

The last sentence of paragraph 5 should read as follows:

The prevalence of **alcohol-use disorders** varies widely across different regions of the world, reaching around 10% in adult men in North America and parts of eastern Europe in 2000.

In paragraph 11, the parenthesis in the second sentence should appear as follows: (i.e. issuing licences with initial limitations on driving privileges, such as a zero limit for blood alcohol concentration), ...
