

Instructions on using the electronic voting system for the nomination and appointment of the Director-General

The Health Assembly, in resolution WHA67.2, approved the recommendation of the Executive Board to rent a cost-effective and secure electronic voting system for the nomination and appointment of the Director-General, and to test such a system through simulation exercises by the governing bodies before the election of the next Director-General.

Step	Comments
Distribution of touchpads and personal identification numbers (PINs)	At the Executive Board, touchpads and PINs will be distributed by the Secretariat to members of the Executive Board at the private meeting(s) where voting takes place.
	At the World Health Assembly, touchpads and PINs will be distributed by the Secretariat at the private meeting(s) where voting takes place. The Secretariat distributes touchpads and PINs to a person seated behind the nameplate of a Member State entitled to vote and only if that person is a "delegate" or "alternate" for that State (as identified in the list of participants).
	Touchpads will be collected at the end of each meeting where voting takes place and will be distributed again at the outset of each further meeting where voting takes place.
	No record is kept of which touchpads and PINs are allocated to particular delegations. In this way, the Secretariat respects and ensures the total anonymity of the vote.
