

Appointment of the Regional Director for Africa

1. The present appointment of Dr Matshidiso Moeti as Regional Director for Africa expires on 31 January 2020.
2. At its sixty-ninth session, the Regional Committee for Africa, in accordance with the provisions of Article 52 of the Constitution of the World Health Organization, and with Rule 52 of its own Rules of Procedure, nominated Dr Matshidiso Moeti as Regional Director for Africa and adopted the following resolution:¹

The Regional Committee,

Considering Article 52 of the Constitution of the World Health Organization; and

In accordance with Rule 52 of the Rules of Procedure of the Regional Committee for Africa,

1. NOMINATES Dr Matshidiso Moeti as Regional Director for the African Region, and
2. REQUESTS the Director-General to propose to the Executive Board the re-appointment of Dr Matshidiso Moeti from 1 February 2020.

ACTION BY THE EXECUTIVE BOARD

3. The Executive Board may wish to consider the above resolution of the Regional Committee for Africa, in accordance with the provisions of Article 52 of the Constitution, and of Rule 48 of the Rules of Procedure of the Executive Board.
4. Further, the Executive Board is invited in this connection to consider the following draft resolution:

The Executive Board,

Considering the provisions of Article 52 of the Constitution of the World Health Organization;

Considering the nomination made by the Regional Committee for Africa at its sixty-ninth session,

1. REAPPOINTS Dr Matshidiso Moeti as Regional Director for Africa as from 1 February 2020;
2. AUTHORIZES the Director-General to issue a contract to Dr Matshidiso Moeti for a period of five years from 1 February 2020, subject to the provisions of the Staff Regulations and Staff Rules.
