Assessment of new Members and Associate Members

Assessment of the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia

Report by the Director-General

- 1. After admission as a new Member of the United Nations, the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia became a new Member of WHO with effect from 28 November 2000.
- 2. Consequently, the Health Assembly must establish the rate of assessment for the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia for the years 2000-2001.
- 3. The principle, established in resolution WHA8.5, and confirmed in resolution WHA24.12, is that the latest available United Nations scale of assessments should be used as a basis for determining the scale of assessments to be used by WHO.
- 4. The United Nations scale for the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia has been fixed at 0.026% for the year 2000 and 0.020% for the year 2001.
- 5. In accordance with past practice, the Director-General recommends that the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia should be assessed at a rate of 0.026% for the financial year 2000, and at 0.020% for the financial year 2001, and that the assessment for 2000 should be reduced to two-twelfths, reflecting the fact that Yugoslavia became a Member in November 2000.

ACTION BY THE HEALTH ASSEMBLY

6. The Health Assembly may wish to consider the adoption of a resolution along the following lines:

The Fifty-fourth World Health Assembly,

Noting that the United Nations General Assembly, in resolution 55/5, established the assessment of the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia at the rate of 0.026% for 2000 and of 0.020% for 2001;

Recalling the principle established in resolution WHA8.5, and confirmed in resolution WHA24.12, that the latest available United Nations scale of assessments should be used as a basis for determining the scale of assessments to be used by WHO,

DECIDES:

- (1) that the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia shall be assessed at an annual rate of 0.026% for the year 2000;
- (2) that its assessment for the year 2000 shall be reduced to two-twelfths of 0.026%;
- (3) that the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia shall be assessed at an annual rate of 0.020% for the year 2001.
