

## **Status of collection of assessed contributions, including Member States in arrears in the payment of their contributions to an extent that would justify invoking Article 7 of the Constitution**

### **Report by the Secretariat**

#### **STATUS OF COLLECTION**

1. In order that WHO may deliver the approved programme budget in full, contributions from Member States must be received in full and on time. All Member States are required under Financial Regulation 6.4 to pay their contribution as of 1 January of the year to which it relates.
2. The rate of collection for 2013 was 85%, down from 87% for 2012. Contributions for 2013 were received, either in full or in part, from 127 of the 196 Members and Associate Members (compared with 131 Members and Associate Members in 2012).<sup>1</sup> For the biennium 2012–2013 as a whole, the rate of collection was 92%, down slightly from 93% for the biennium 2010–2011. Details of amounts assessed and collected are shown in Annex 1.
3. Unpaid contributions as at 31 December 2013 amounted to US\$ 76.4 million, with a further US\$ 38.0 million due under special arrangements authorized by the Health Assembly (compared with US\$ 65.2 million and US\$ 39.0 million, respectively, at 31 December 2012). Details of payments made to date in respect of special arrangements are shown in Annex 2.

#### **MEMBERS' CONTRIBUTIONS RECEIVED IN ADVANCE**

4. As at 31 December 2013, some Members had made advance payments, either in full or in part, against their regular budget contributions for 2014 and future years. In total, contributions received in advance as at 31 December 2013 amounted to US\$ 57.1 million (compared with US\$ 60.4 million at 31 December 2012). Advance payments are detailed by Member State in Annex 3.

#### **MEMBERS IN ARREARS AND SPECIAL ARRANGEMENTS**

5. Article 7 of the Constitution states that "If a Member fails to meet its financial obligations to the Organization ... the Health Assembly may ... suspend the voting privileges ... to which a Member is entitled." If, at the time of the opening of the Health Assembly, a Member is in arrears in an amount

that equals or exceeds the amount of contributions due from it for the preceding two full years, the Health Assembly takes a decision on suspension of the Member's voting privileges in accordance with resolution WHA41.7.

6. In accordance with previous Health Assembly resolutions, the voting privileges of the following five Member States continue to be suspended: Central African Republic, Comoros, Grenada, Guinea Bissau and Somalia. Details of the amounts outstanding are provided in Annex 4. The suspension is to continue at the Sixty-seventh and subsequent Health Assemblies until the arrears have been reduced to a level below the amount that would justify invoking Article 7 of the Constitution.

7. In accordance with resolution WHA66.13 if, by the time of the opening of the Sixty-seventh World Health Assembly, the following five Member States, Antigua and Barbuda, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Cote d'Ivoire, Jordan and Malawi are still in arrears in the payment of their contributions to an extent that would justify invoking Article 7 of the Constitution, their voting privileges shall also be suspended as from the opening. Details of the amounts outstanding are provided in Annex 4. The suspension will then continue at the Sixty-eighth and subsequent Health Assemblies until the arrears have been reduced to a level below the amount that would justify invoking Article 7 of the Constitution.

8. As at 6 March 2014, 18 Member States, namely Egypt, Eritrea, Ethiopia, Fiji, Gambia, Kiribati, Lao People's Democratic Republic, Lesotho, Mauritania, Montenegro, Palau, Rwanda, Saint Vincent and the Grenadines, Senegal, South Sudan, Suriname, Syrian Arab Republic and Togo were in arrears in the payment of their contributions in amounts that equal or exceed the amounts due from them for the preceding two full years, as listed in Annex 4. One Associate Member, Puerto Rico, is also behind with its assessed contributions.

9. Pursuant to resolution WHA41.7, unless there are exceptional circumstances justifying a different measure, the Sixty-seventh World Health Assembly may wish to adopt a resolution deciding that the voting privileges of the 18 Member States mentioned in paragraph 8 will be suspended as from the opening day of the Sixty-eighth World Health Assembly in May 2015, if at that time the Member States concerned are still in arrears to the extent that would justify invoking Article 7 of the Constitution.

10. Member States in arrears of payment to an extent that they are concerned by Article 7 of the Constitution are encouraged to submit proposals to the Health Assembly for repaying such arrears over an extended period. Such proposals for special arrangements are considered by the Programme, Budget and Administration Committee of the Executive Board, which subsequently makes its recommendations to the Health Assembly. As of 6 March 2014, no new proposal has been submitted.

11. Annex 2 lists the 11 Member States that currently have special arrangements for repayment of arrears approved by the Health Assembly at previous sessions. Payments totalling US\$ 2.5 million were received in the biennium 2012–2013 (compared with US\$ 6.3 million in 2010–2011) in accordance with these special arrangements. Six of the Member States concerned are respecting their commitments under these arrangements. Five Member States, Afghanistan, Central African Republic, Kyrgyzstan, Tajikistan and Ukraine, are not respecting their commitments. Of those five Member States, Central African Republic has already had its voting privileges suspended. In the cases of Afghanistan, Kyrgyzstan, Tajikistan and Ukraine, unless further payments are made by the opening of the Sixty-seventh World Health Assembly, the four Member States will lose their voting privileges.

## **ACTION BY THE HEALTH ASSEMBLY**

12. No action is required by the Health Assembly in respect of those Members whose voting privileges have already been suspended under previous Health Assembly resolutions.

13. The Health Assembly may wish to consider the following draft resolution in respect of Egypt, Eritrea, Ethiopia, Fiji, Gambia, Kiribati, Lao People's Democratic Republic, Lesotho, Mauritania, Montenegro, Palau, Rwanda, Saint Vincent and the Grenadines, Senegal, South Sudan, Suriname, Syrian Arab Republic and Togo, in accordance with the principles stated in resolution WHA41.7:

The Sixty-seventh World Health Assembly,

Having considered the report on status of collection of assessed contributions, including Members in arrears in the payment of their contributions to an extent that would justify invoking Article 7 of the Constitution, and special arrangements for settlement of arrears;<sup>1</sup>

Noting that, at the time of opening of the Sixty-seventh World Health Assembly, the voting rights of Central African Republic, Comoros, Grenada, Guinea-Bissau and Somalia were suspended, such suspension to continue until the arrears of the Members concerned have been reduced, at the present or future Health Assemblies, to a level below the amount that would justify invoking Article 7 of the Constitution;

Noting that the voting rights of Antigua and Barbuda, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Côte d'Ivoire, Jordan and Malawi were suspended during the Sixty-sixth World Health Assembly, effective from the Sixty-seventh World Health Assembly and to continue until the arrears of the Members concerned have been reduced, at the present or future Health Assemblies, to a level below the amount that would justify invoking Article 7 of the Constitution;

Noting that Afghanistan, Egypt, Eritrea, Ethiopia, Fiji, Gambia, Kiribati, Kyrgyzstan, Lao People's Democratic Republic, Lesotho, Mauritania, Montenegro, Palau, Rwanda, Saint Vincent and the Grenadines, Senegal, South Sudan, Suriname, Syrian Arab Republic, Tajikistan, Togo and Ukraine were in arrears at the time of the opening of the Sixty-seventh World Health Assembly to such an extent that it was necessary for the Health Assembly to consider, in accordance with Article 7 of the Constitution, whether the voting privileges of those countries should be suspended – for Afghanistan, Kyrgyzstan, Tajikistan and Ukraine at the opening of the Sixty-seventh World Health Assembly, and for the remaining 18 Member States at the opening of the Sixty-eighth World Health Assembly,

DECIDES:

(1) that in accordance with the statement of principles set out in resolution WHA41.7 if, by the time of the opening of the Sixty-eighth World Health Assembly, Egypt, Eritrea, Ethiopia, Fiji, Gambia, Kiribati, Lao People's Democratic Republic, Lesotho, Mauritania, Montenegro, Palau, Rwanda, Saint Vincent and the Grenadines, Senegal, South Sudan, Suriname, Syrian Arab Republic and Togo are still in arrears in the payment of their contributions to an extent that would justify invoking Article 7 of the Constitution, their

voting privileges shall be suspended as from the said opening; and in accordance with resolutions WHA59.6, WHA61.8, WHA66.14 and WHA64.20 if, by the time of the opening of the Sixty-seventh World Health Assembly, Afghanistan, Kyrgyzstan, Tajikistan and Ukraine, respectively, are still in arrears in the payment of their rescheduled assessments, their voting privileges shall be suspended automatically;

(2) that any suspension that takes effect as set out in paragraph (1) above shall continue at the Sixty-eighth World Health Assembly and subsequent Health Assemblies until the arrears of Afghanistan, Egypt, Eritrea, Ethiopia, Fiji, Gambia, Kiribati, Kyrgyzstan, Lao People's Democratic Republic, Lesotho, Mauritania, Montenegro, Palau, Rwanda, Saint Vincent and the Grenadines, Senegal, South Sudan, Suriname, Syrian Arab Republic, Tajikistan, Togo and Ukraine have been reduced to a level below the amount that would justify invoking Article 7 of the Constitution;

(3) that this decision shall be without prejudice to the right of any Member to request restoration of its voting privileges in accordance with Article 7 of the Constitution.
