Written statement, RH Helen Clark, Chair of The Independent Panel for Pandemic Preparedness and Response

"Greetings. I appreciate the efforts to prepare the negotiating text before you.

I have four points.

First – the objective must be more measurable. One can prepare poorly and respond poorly. The objective must be to prevent, prepare for, and respond to pandemics, in order to protect <u>all</u> people and minimise the health, economic and social impacts.

Second – The investment in pandemic preparedness and response is a <u>common good</u>, and should be reflected in the text as such.

Third – this is an historic opportunity to agree a treaty. It is an imperative to change the inadequate status quo. What you negotiate here must contribute to a transformed, coherent system that ensures an equitable, rapid, effective, clear, and collaborative approach to pandemic threats. Clearly stated, legally binding <u>commitments</u> which are measurable are needed.

Fourth - Remember: you are negotiating on behalf of 8 billion people. You must be certain that the agreement you negotiate will provide the protection needed for all people.
