STAFF PENSION COMMITTEE: APPOINTMENT OF  
REPRESENTATIVES TO REPLACE MEMBERS WHOSE  
PERIOD OF MEMBERSHIP IS EXPIRING(Provisional Agenda item A.F. & L. 6.4.3.1)

In conformity with the regulations of the United Nations Joint Staff Pension Fund WHO has set up a Staff Pension Committee composed, according to a decision of the Second World Health Assembly,<sup>1</sup> of nine members (and nine alternate members), three appointed by the Health Assembly, three by the Director-General, and three elected by the participants of the Fund. The appointment is normally for a period of three years, but the Second World Health Assembly decided that when the Staff Pension Committee was first constituted, one-third of the members and their alternates should be appointed for a period of one year, one-third for a period of two years, and one-third for a period of three years.<sup>2</sup>

The representatives of the Health Assembly on the Committee are:

## (a) Appointed by the Second World Health Assembly

- (i) for a period of two years:  
Sir Arcot Mudalier, member  
Dr. B. Kozusznik, alternate member
- (ii) for a period of three years:  
Dr. H. Hyde, member  
Dr. J.A. Höjer, alternate member

## (b) Appointed by the Third World Health Assembly

for a period of three years:  
The member of the Executive Board  
designated by the Government of France, member  
The member of the Executive Board  
designated by the Government of Chile, alternate member
