WORKING CAPITAL FUND FOR 1952
(Provisional Agenda item 6.6.3.3.)

1. The Executive Board at its seventh Session recommended that paragraph 1 of the draft Resolution on the Working Capital Fund for 1952 as shown in Official Records No.31, page 48 be changed to read as follows:¹

1. RESOLVES that the Working Capital Fund for the present membership be maintained for 1952 in the amount of U.S.\$3,192,032.85.

2. Since that date Panama has become a Member of the World Health Organization and has been assessed an advance to the Working Capital Fund which would increase the size of the fund to \$3,193,955.

3. Certain other countries have also applied for membership in the Organization and should their applications be accepted by the Fourth World Health Assembly, those countries will also be required to make advances to the fund.

4. In order to provide for the assessment of Panama and for the assessment of any future Members, it is suggested that paragraph 1 of the resolution should read as follows:

1. RESOLVES that the Working Capital Fund for the membership as at 1 May 1951 be maintained for 1952 in the amount of \$3,193,955 plus the assessments of Members joining after 1 May 1951.
