

AFR/RC28/R13: Use of Portuguese as one of the working languages of the Regional Office for Africa of WHO

The Regional Committee,

Having examined the Regional Director's report on the use of the Portuguese language at the Regional Office for Africa;¹

Having considered the plan for the phased introduction of the Portuguese language in the Regional Office for Africa,

1. THANKS the Regional Director for his report;
2. RECOMMENDS the adoption of the Portuguese language as a working language of the Regional Committee for Africa and its use at the Regional Office for Africa;
3. ENDORSES the plan outlined in the report; and
4. REQUESTS the Director-General to submit this plan to the Executive Board, so that the first phase may be implemented in 1979, and that appropriate provision for the second phase of the plan be included in the proposed programme budget for 1980-1981.
