



WHO STAFF PENSION COMMITTEE: APPOINTMENT OF REPRESENTATIVES  
TO REPLACE MEMBERS WHOSE PERIOD OF MEMBERSHIP EXPIRES

In conformity with the Regulations of the United Nations Joint Staff Pension Fund and according to a decision of the Second World Health Assembly,<sup>1</sup> WHO has set up a Staff Pension Committee composed of nine members (and nine alternate members): three appointed by the Health Assembly, three by the Director-General and three elected by the participants of the Fund. Each appointment is for a period of three years:

The representatives of the Health Assembly are:

- (1) Appointed by the Seventh World Health Assembly<sup>2</sup>

The member of the Executive Board designated by the Government of the Union of South Africa

The member of the Executive Board designated by the Government of Japan (alternate)

- (2) Appointed by the Eighth World Health Assembly<sup>3</sup>

The member of the Executive Board designated by the Government of Argentina

The member of the Executive Board designated by the Government of Finland (alternate)

- (3) Appointed by the Ninth World Health Assembly<sup>4</sup>

The member of the Executive Board designated by the Government of Canada

The member of the Executive Board designated by the Government of Italy (alternate)

As the appointments made by the Seventh World Health Assembly expire in May 1957, the Tenth World Health Assembly is called upon to appoint one member and one alternate member to the Staff Pension Committee, the appointments to be for the normal period of three years.

Following the precedent established by previous Assemblies, the Tenth World Health Assembly may wish to choose its representatives on the Staff Pension Committee from among the members of the Executive Board by designating the names of State Members entitled to appoint a person to the Executive Board.

If the Assembly should find these proposals satisfactory it may wish to consider adopting the following resolution:

"The Tenth World Health Assembly

RESOLVES that the member of the Executive Board designated by the Government of \_\_\_\_\_ be appointed as member of the WHO Staff Pension Committee, and that the member of the Board designated by the Government of \_\_\_\_\_ be appointed as alternate member, the appointments being for a period of three years."
