SECOND REPORT OF STANDING COMMITTEE ON
NON-GOVERNMENTAL ORGANIZATIONS

The Committee held its second meeting on Tuesday, 12 July 1949 at 4.0 p.m. and its third meeting on Thursday 14 July at 2.0 p.m., both under the Chairmanship of Dr. G.H. de Paula Souza.

Applications for Relations with WHO

The Committee discussed various applications for relations with WHO, upon the basis of the criteria laid down by the First World Health Assembly,¹ and decided to recommend to the Board the adoption of the resolutions which are set forth below:

The Executive Board

(1) In pursuance of the resolution adopted by the Second World Health Assembly²

DECIDES to establish official relations with the Council for the Co-ordination of International Congresses of Medical Sciences, on the basis of the principles laid down in Off. Rec. World Hlth Org. 13, 326-327.

(2) DECIDES to establish official relations with the Biometric Society on the basis of the principles laid down in Off. Rec. World Hlth Org. 13, 326-327

(3) CONSIDERS that the International Federation of Unions of Employees of Public and Civil Services does not fulfil the criteria established by the Health Assembly, and REQUESTS the Director-General to inform the Federation of the decision of the Board regarding organizations not mainly concerned with health.

(4) Since the information received from the remaining organizations which were considered by the Committee is not sufficient to show that these organizations fulfil all the criteria,

DECIDES to postpone consideration of these requests until the fifth meeting of the Board,

REQUESTS the Director-General to inform the several organizations of this decision, and

REQUESTS the Director-General to revise the questionnaire, taking into consideration the comments of the Committee

(5) REQUESTS that the information concerning applications for relations should be submitted to the Committee by mail at least six weeks before the date of each session of the Board.
