## REGIONAL ORGANIZATION FOR AFRICA

At the preliminary meeting of the representatives of the Member States and the associate Member of the African Region held in Geneva on the 11th June, the Director-General was informed by the Representative of the Union of South Africa that a cable had been sent by his Government on the 15th May confirming its consent, which cable was not included in document EB8/21.

As this cable had not been received by the Director-General a repeat was requested from the Union Government.

The Director-General now has the honour to amplify EB8/21 by attaching the following cable received 14/6/51:
