## **TIME AND PLACE OF FORTHCOMING SESSIONS OF THE REGIONAL COMMITTEE**

### **FIFTY-SIXTH SESSION**

The Regional Committee, at its fifty-fourth session, held in Yangon, Myanmar, in September 2001, reiterated its earlier decision to hold the fifty-sixth session of the Regional Committee in 2003 at the WHO Regional Office for South-East Asia in New Delhi, India.

The session of the Regional Committee for South-East Asia is normally held in the second week of September so as not to overlap with the sessions of the other Regional Committees.

### **FIFTY-SEVENTH SESSION**

The Regional Committee, at its fifty-fourth session, accepted the invitation of the Government of the Republic of Maldives to host the fifty-seventh session in Maldives in 2004. (resolution SEA/RC54/3). Accordingly, the Regional Director proposes to make suitable arrangements to convene the fifty-seventh session in Maldives in September 2004. The Government of the Republic of Maldives may wish to reconfirm its invitation to enable the Regional Committee to decide on the venue and time of the fifty-seventh session.

### **FIFTY-EIGHTH SESSION**

No Member State has as yet extended an invitation to host the fifty-eighth session of the Regional Committee. In case no such invitation is extended, the Regional Director would decide to hold the fifty-eighth session of the Regional Committee in 2005 at the WHO Regional Office for South-East Asia in New Delhi, India.
