EVALUATION OF THE STRATEGIES FOR HEALTH FOR ALL

The Regional Committee,

Recalling World Health Assembly resolution WHA34.36 and its own resolution SEA/RC43/R2 urging Member States to monitor progress and to undertake the evaluation of their Health for All strategies and report the results in the agreed common framework,

Appreciating the responses of all Member States in completing the second evaluation of the Health for All strategies, reporting therein the strengths and weaknesses of the strategies and the implementation processes,

Reiterating the need for Member States to integrate the monitoring and evaluation processes of the Health for All strategies into the national health development processes in general and into the Government/WHO collaborative actions in particular,

1. **ENDORSES** the review of the second evaluation of the strategies for Health for All and the submission of the same as the regional contribution to the Eighth World Health Situation Report;

2. **URGES** Member States:

- (a) To continue to assess their Health for All policies and strategies in the light of the results of the evaluation and to modify or strengthen them as necessary;
- (b) To strengthen their health information systems, with particular reference to the underserved and disadvantaged sections of the population in a spirit of equity and social justice;
- (c) To strengthen the health management systems and improve community participation by adopting social mobilization strategies, and
- (d) To strengthen their evaluation processes by involving other sectors where necessary, and

3. **REQUESTS** the Regional Director to support Member States for further improving the monitoring and evaluation of their Health for All strategies.
