**REGIONAL COMMITTEE FOR SOUTH EAST ASIA**

**SEA/RC41/R6 DEVELOPMENT OF WATER SUPPLY AND SANITATION - THRUST FOR  
FURTHER ACTION**

The Regional Committee,

Recalling its earlier resolutions SEA/RC32/R4 and SEA/RC33/R9 on the crucial role of safe drinking water supply and sanitation for the attainment of Health for All by the Year 2000;

Noting that despite the efforts of the Member States progress continues to remain short of expectations;

Noting further the 'Action Agenda' recommended by the Regional Consultation on IDWSSD, held in July 1988;

1. URGES Member States:

- (a) to review at the earliest the progress of water supply and sanitation programmes, to accelerate implementation and to revise their targets and, if necessary, strategies so as to meet the goal of HFA, and
- (b) to mobilize resources, both national and international, for accelerated implementation in accordance with the recommendations of the Regional Consultation on IDWSSD, and

2. REQUESTS the Regional Director to continue support to Member States in their efforts to accelerate the implementation of their IDWSSD programmes.
