SEA/RC32/R1

FORMULATION OF STRATEGIES FOR HEALTH FOR ALL
BY THE YEAR 2000

The Regional Committee,

Reaffirming World Health Assembly resolution WHA30.43 expressing the determination of the Member States to attain the social goal of an acceptable level of health for all their people by the year 2000,

Noting with satisfaction the significant contribution of Member States of this region to the historic International Conference on Primary Health Care,

Taking into account the basic principles, guidelines and timetable for the formulation of strategies for health for all by the year 2000 outlined in the Assembly document A32/8,*

Recalling resolution WHA32.30 which endorsed the report of the International Conference on Primary Health Care and the Alma Ata declaration and outlined wide-ranging actions for the formulation of strategies by Member States and WHO in collaboration with other international agencies and organizations, and

Having considered the information from Member States on the current status of preparatory activities and plans concerning the formulation of strategies for the attainment of the social goal of health for all,

1. URGES Member States:

- (a) to proceed urgently, and on the basis of the agreed timetable, with the formulation of national policies, strategies and plans of action leading to meaningful programmes for the attainment of health for all by the year 2000;
- (b) to report to the next session of the Regional Committee on the detailed national strategies and plans of action;
- (c) to collaborate collectively with WHO in the formulation of regional strategies in support of national strategies, and

2. REQUESTS the Regional Director:

- (a) to collaborate with Member States in activities leading to the formulation of national strategies, plans of action and programmes for achieving health for all by the year 2000;

- (b) to ensure that national and regional strategies are fully taken into account in the preparation of the Seventh General Programme of Work, and
- (c) to take all measures required to coordinate and support the formulation of regional strategies to support activities at national and regional level aimed at achieving health for all by the year 2000.
