

**RESOLUTIONS**  
OF THE  
**REGIONAL COMMITTEE FOR SOUTH EAST ASIA**

**LONG-TERM PLANNING**

The Regional Committee,

Having considered the Twenty-second World Health Assembly's resolution on long-term planning in the field of health, biennial programming and the improvement of the evaluation process(WHA22.53),

1. NOTES that the Director-General has been requested to ask Member States to send in observations on questions of long-term planning;
2. CONFIRMS that this subject - in particular, the formulation of the Fifth General Programme of Work for a Specific Period for WHO - should be initiated at the country level;
3. URGES Member Governments to send their recommendations for this programme to the Regional Director by the end of January 1970, to enable him to consolidate their recommendations into a regional plan to be submitted to the twenty-third session of the Regional Committee for South-East Asia, and
4. REQUESTS the Regional Director to give governments all possible assistance for this purpose as requested, through the WHO Representatives and through consultants.
