ADMISSION OF NEW MEMBERS AND ASSOCIATE MEMBERS

Application by the Sultanate of Muscat and Oman for
Admission to Membership

The Director-General has the honour to inform the Health Assembly that on 8 April 1962 he received a cable dated 7 April 1962 from the Sultanate of Muscat and Oman. The text of this cable, which was received by the Director-General within the time limit provided in Rule 109 of the Rules of Procedure of the Health Assembly, is set out below:

"FROM SALALAH OMAN TO THE DIRECTOR GENERAL THE WORLD HEALTH ORGANISATION PALAIS DES NATIONS GENEVA SWITZERLAND SALALAH OMAN 65 BEGINS APRIL SEVEN GREETINGS THIS IS TO CONFIRM OUR LETTER DATED MARCH FIVE 1962 APPLYING TO JOIN THE WORLD HEALTH ORGANISATION THE LETTER HAS BEEN DESPATCHED ON THE SAME DATE A SECOND LETTER HAS BEEN SENT YESTERDAY REQUEST THAT IT BE PLACED BEFORE THE NEXT HEALTH ASSEMBLY PD SULTAN OF MUSCAT AND OMAN PD SAID"

The letter of March 5 to which the cable refers was received by the Director-General on 11 April 1962. The text of this letter is set out below:

"My dear Director-General,

Being desirous that our Sultanate of Muscat and Oman should become a member of the World Health Organisation we write to make our application in accordance with Article 6 of the Constitution, with the request that it be placed before the next Health Assembly.
