SCALES OF ASSESSMENT FOR 1962 AND 1963
(ASSESSMENTS OF NEW MEMBERS AND ASSOCIATE MEMBERS)

Report by the Director-General

1. The Fifteenth World Health Assembly in resolution WHA15.16 has admitted Western Samoa to membership in the Organization and, in resolutions WHA15. and WHA15. , admitted Jamaica and Uganda to associate membership.
2. It will be necessary for the Assembly to fix the assessment of Western Samoa for 1962 and 1963, the World Health Assembly having already fixed the assessment of Associate Members at 0.02 per cent. in resolution WHA13.16.¹
3. As it has not been possible to consult the United Nations Committee on Contributions regarding the assessment for Western Samoa, the Director-General suggests that its assessment be fixed for 1962 and 1963 at the minimum of 0.04 per cent.
4. The Assembly may, therefore, wish to consider the adoption of a resolution along the following lines:

"The Fifteenth World Health Assembly,
Noting the admission of Western Samoa to membership in the Organization,
DECIDES that Western Samoa shall be assessed for 1962 and 1963 at
0.04 per cent."
5. In addition to establishing the assessments for these Members, the Health Assembly may further wish to consider whether Jamaica and Uganda, which are carrying out malaria programmes, shall be eligible for credits in 1962 in the same way as those Members listed in Schedule A attached to the Appropriation Resolution for the Financial Year 1962. Should the Assembly decide to grant credits in 1963, it may wish to extend such credits to Jamaica and Uganda. In these circumstances, the Assembly may wish to consider the adoption of a resolution along the following lines:

"The Fifteenth World Health Assembly,

DECIDES that, since Jamaica and Uganda are carrying out Malaria Programmes, they are eligible for credits in 1962 and 1963 in the same way as those Members listed in Schedule A attached to the Appropriation Resolutions for the Financial Years 1962 and 1963."
