ORGANIZATIONAL STUDY: CO-ORDINATION WITH THE
UNITED NATIONS AND THE SPECIALIZED AGENCIES

The Thirteenth World Health Assembly adopted a resolution, WHA13.61,¹ requesting the Executive Board to study co-ordination with the United Nations and the specialized agencies and to report on the study to the Fifteenth World Health Assembly.

The Executive Board, having studied the question at its twenty-seventh, twenty-eighth and twenty-ninth sessions, adopted at its twenty-ninth session a resolution EB29.R52,² transmitting to the Fifteenth World Health Assembly the organizational study: Co-ordination with the United Nations and the specialized agencies. The text of this study has been edited by the Rapporteur of the Executive Board, in compliance with the wishes of the Board, so as to include the comments made by it, and has been published in the proceedings of the twenty-ninth session of the Executive Board, Part I.³

The Executive Board, in its resolution EB29.R52, also recommended to the Health Assembly that it adopt a resolution, the proposed text of which is to be found in the same volume.²
