ASSESSMENT FOR 1965 AND 1966 OF NEW MEMBERS

Report by the Director-General

1. The following States, Members of the United Nations, became Members of the World Health Organization by depositing with the Secretary-General of the United Nations a formal instrument of acceptance of the WHO Constitution on the dates shown:

<u>State</u>	<u>Date</u>
Maldives Islands	5 November 1965
Singapore	25 February 1966

2. It will be necessary for the Assembly to fix the assessments of these Members. Their assessments have been fixed at 0.04 per cent. - the minimum - in the United Nations scale of assessment.

3. When fixing the assessment of the Maldives Islands for 1965 the Assembly will wish to take into consideration paragraph 1 of resolution WHA17.10¹ which reads as follows:

"1. DECIDES, in principle, that new Members joining the Organization in the last six months of a year shall be assessed at the normal rate, but that the contribution for the year shall be reduced by 50 per cent."

4. Based on the above considerations, the Assembly may wish to consider the adoption of a resolution along the following lines:

"The Nineteenth World Health Assembly,

Noting that the Maldives Islands and Singapore became Members of the Organization by depositing with the Secretary-General of the United Nations a formal instrument of acceptance of the WHO Constitution,

DECIDES

- (1) that these Members shall be assessed as follows:

<u>Member State</u>	<u>1965</u>	<u>1966</u>
Maldives Islands	0.04 per cent.	0.04 per cent.
Singapore		0.04 per cent.

- (2) that the 1965 contribution of the Maldives Islands shall be reduced by 50 per cent, in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 1 of resolution WHA17.10."
