PERIODICITY OF THE REVIEW OF RELATIONS BETWEEN
WHO AND THE NON-GOVERNMENTAL ORGANIZATIONS

(Draft resolution submitted by Professor P. Macúch)

The Executive Board,

Considering that the working principles governing the admission of non-governmental organizations into relations with WHO (paragraph 2(vi)) provide that the Executive Board, through its Standing Committee, shall review every four years the list of non-governmental organizations in official relations with WHO;

Considering that the members of the Executive Board are only designated for three years;

Considering it desirable to harmonize the periodicity of the review of relations between WHO and the non-governmental organizations with the duration of the term of office of Board members;

Recognizing that it would be useful for all members of the Executive Board to be adequately informed on the co-operation existing between WHO and the non-governmental organizations in official relations with the Organization; and

Desirous of ensuring close and cordial co-operation with these non-governmental organizations,

1. INVITES the Director-General to submit to it each year, for information, any data of interest that may be available to him on co-operation between WHO and the non-governmental organizations in official relations; and
2. RECOMMENDS to the Twenty-first World Health Assembly that it adopt the following resolution:

"The Twenty-first World Health Assembly,

Considering resolution EB41.R adopted by the Executive Board at its forty-first session,

DECIDES to amend as follows paragraph 2(vi) of the working principles governing the admission of non-governmental organizations into official relations with WHO:¹

third line: replace "every four years" by "every three years".
