REPORT OF THE STANDING COMMITTEE ON NON-GOVERNMENTAL ORGANIZATIONS

The Standing Committee on Non-governmental Organizations met on 26 January 1971.

The following members were present: Dr D. Arnaudov, Dr O. Avilés, Professor S. Halter and Dr Y. R. Joshi.

Professor S. Halter was unanimously elected Chairman.

1. The Committee decided to postpone the consideration of the application of one non-governmental organization, whose questionnaire was submitted too late to be communicated to members of the Executive Board within the time limit set in resolution EB8.R54, paragraph 2, of the Executive Board.<sup>1</sup> The Committee then considered the applications submitted by 11 non-governmental organizations on the basis of questionnaires completed by those organizations, and in the light of the criteria established in part 1 of the Working Principles Governing the Admission of Non-governmental Organizations into Official Relations with WHO.<sup>2</sup>

2. In conclusion of its study, the Standing Committee was satisfied that the following organizations:

- World Federation of Public Health Associations
- International Standardization Organization
- International Association of Medical Laboratory Technicians
- International League Against Epilepsy
- International Association of Agricultural Medicine
- International Solid Wastes and Public Cleansing Association

met the criteria referred to above and decided, therefore, to recommend to the Executive Board the adoption of the following resolution:

"The Executive Board,

Having examined the report of the Standing Committee on Non-governmental Organizations,

DECIDES to establish official relations with the following organizations, on the basis of the criteria laid down in the Working Principles Governing the Admission of Non-governmental Organizations into Official Relations with WHO:
