FIRST REPORT OF COMMITTEE B TO COMMITTEE A

Committee B reviewed the amount of casual income available from miscellaneous income and the cash portion of the Assembly Suspense Account in the light of a report by the Director-General.¹ It also took into consideration the reimbursement from the Technical Assistance component of the United Nations Development Programme.

On the basis of its review, and bearing in mind the desirability to avoid an unusual increase in Members' contributions for 1972 resulting from the salary increases for professional and higher categories of staff decided upon by the General Assembly of the United Nations, Committee B recommends to Committee A that an amount of US\$ 3 268 600 be used to help finance the 1972 budget.

The amount of US\$ 3 268 600 is composed of the expected reimbursement from the Technical Assistance component of the United Nations Development Programme in the amount of US\$ 1 268 600, and the amount of US\$ 2 000 000 of available miscellaneous income.
