1. PROGRESS OF WORK OF THE MAIN COMMITTEES

The Committee heard statements from the Chairmen of the main committees on the progress of the work of their committees.

2. TRANSMISSION TO THE HEALTH ASSEMBLY OF REPORTS OF THE MAIN COMMITTEES (Document A24/18)

The Committee decided to transmit to the Health Assembly the second report of Committee B (document A24/18).

3. PROGRAMME OF WORK OF THE HEALTH ASSEMBLY

The DIRECTOR-GENERAL announced that he had been visited by two United Nations representatives, who, in accordance with the wish expressed by the Secretary-General, should participate in the discussions of Committee B on health assistance to refugees and displaced persons in the Middle East (agenda item 3.10). Committee B might therefore commence by considering that item at its meeting on Thursday afternoon.

It was so agreed.

The Committee then drew up the programme of the meetings for the afternoon of Friday, 14 May. It was decided that at 2.30 p.m. Committee A would consider the amount of the effective working budget and budget level for 1972; consequently Committee B would not meet while Committee A was dealing with that item.
