COMMITTEE ON CREDENTIALS

Second Report

The Committee on Credentials met on 13 May 1976.

The Committee accepted as formal the credentials presented on behalf of Albania, Barbados, Cape Verde, Lao People's Democratic Republic, Liberia and Peru, and accordingly proposes that the Health Assembly should recognize the validity of the credentials of these countries.

The Committee examined a notification from Benin which could not be considered as constituting a formal credential. The Committee, nevertheless, recommends to the Health Assembly that this credential be provisionally recognized pending the arrival of a formal credential.
